



## KENWOOD NURSERY

### Kenwood Day Nursery Stretford fees and funding – from 1 April 2026

Stretford's daily rate is £80 per day. The nursery operates a 3 day minimum. If a 3 day place is booked, one of the days must be a Monday or Friday.

3 days	£1,040 per month
4 days	£1,386.67 per month
5 days	£1,733.33 per month

#### Government childcare funding

**30 hours** - for families in receipt of 30 hours funding, the 38 weeks of funding is stretched across the year at 21.92 hours per week.

3 day place (8.08 additional private hours)	£280.11 per month
4 day place (18.08 additional private hours)	£626.77 per month
5 day place (28.08 additional private hours)	£973.44 per month

**15 hours** - for families in receipt of 15 hours funding, the 38 weeks of funding is stretched across the year at 10.96 hours per week.

3 day place (19.04 additional private hours)	£660.05 per month
4 day place (29.04 additional private hours)	£1,006.72 per month
5 day place (39.04 additional private hours)	£1,353.39 per month

All invoices are issued monthly and are fully itemised to comply with Department for Education's requirements.

**Supplementary costs** - For children in receipt of 3 and 4 year old funding, a voluntary supplement is chargeable.

Meals and snacks Breakfast, lunch, afternoon tea and snacks	£1 per hour of funded care	£21.92 per week/£94.99 per month of funded care
Consumables eg. Nappies, wipes, nappy cream, sacks, sun-cream, Tapestry journal membership	£0.25 per hour of funded care	£5.48 per week/£23.75 per month of funded care
Activities eg. Music or foreign language sessions, outings and trips, visits from guest educators	£0.25 per hour of funded care	£5.48 per week/£23.75 per month of funded care

If parents do not wish to pay the supplements, please speak to the nursery about alternatives.

A deposit of £250 is payable when booking a place, this is return to parents within one month of a child leaving the nursery after any outstanding accounts have been paid. Please see terms and conditions for full details.

For children starting between 1 April and 31 August, funding is spread differently, as only one 'term' of funding is available. Parents will be advised how this impacts them if relevant.
